

Farming: exclusively animal ‘farming’ for the purposes of the Vegatopia bibliography. Vegatopia considers animal ‘farming’ to be a euphemism for enslavement. The placing of ‘farming’ in quotation marks therefore indicates our refusal of the beneficent connotations of farming in commonsense understandings of the term. We have prioritized anti-animal-‘farming’ sources, but also included here are pro-animal farming sources – as for the category of animal abuse, this has been done so that such information can be subjected to critique.
